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Sunset park It is located in the department of La Libertad, as part of the SurfCity marine coastal strip SurfCity. It is one of the new favorite tourist places for Salvadorans and foreigners, being the first park built over the sea, therefore becoming one of the main tourist attractions in El Salvador. It has several attractions, among which are La Noria, El Carrusel, Pirate Ship, Roller Coaster, which have made this park popular, directed by the government and is the new sensation of the country. El Tunco It is one of the most visited beaches by both Salvadorans and foreigners; characterized for being a rocky beach, as well as for being one of the best beaches to practice the sport of surfing, but the most important feature and from which it derives its name is the rock shaped like a "Tunco" (way of calling the pig). Around the beach there are a variety of restaurants where you can enjoy delicious meals, as well as bars and lodging where you can spend your vacations. Joya de Ceren Located in the department of La Libertad, is the most important archaeological site in El Salvador, also classified as one of the most important in Mesoamerica, being declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, because it is part of the history of the Mayan culture of Central America In this site is preserved and reflects the daily life of the Mayas, before the Spanish conquest; being discovered by accident the remains of a small farm that had been buried by volcanic ash, becoming an important site for El Salvador.
